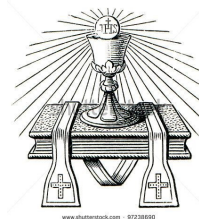

Easter Monday Mass:

What used to be known as the 'Easter Men's Mass' for North Staffordshire will be celebrated at Holy Trinity at 10am on Mon by Bishop David McGough. It is the Centenary year, as the first took place at St Chad's Cathedral, Birmingham on Easter Monday 1919. It had its origins as a counter demonstration against those who questioned the belief in the 'Real Presence' in the Blessed Sacrament but also the men of the city wanting to pray for their relatives and friends who died during the First World War. It would be lovely to see as many people as possible coming to this Mass to affirm our faith in Christ's presence and to pray for the dead, two important and defining Catholic beliefs.
